DEADLINE FOR NOMINATIONS:

Please return the completed Nomination for Election Form to the College office **before 4:00pm on September 30, 2010**. No late nominations will be accepted. Only the original form will be accepted (no faxes or photocopies).

NOMINATION PROFILE

Nominees for election are to enclose his or her profile with the **Nomination for Election Form**. Information about the profile is found on page 2 of the Nomination for Election Form.

VOTING

If there is only one nominee for an Electoral District, the Registrar will declare the sole nominee to be elected by acclamation. If there is more than one nominee, the Registrar will prepare and deliver an election ballot before November 30, 2010 to all registrants living in the Electoral District.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ELECTION:

To be eligible, the member must be a qualified registrant of the College. He or she must live or work in opticianry in the Electoral District for which he or she is nominated. The member must not be in default of payment of any prescribed fees.
